Since 2004, "Desert Reach" has been sharing this FREE program with all fourth grade classrooms of schools in the Cave Creek, and North Scottsdale communities.

Over 9,000 students have experienced, enjoyed and benefited from the hands-on conservation based program.

Working in teams of 3-6, trained volunteers share aspects of the desert with student teams who observe and gather data using desert specific journals.



Programs are presented on Tuesdays and Thursdays from January through April on a first ask basis until all dates are filled.
